Technical Qualifications and Experience

Project Management

VTI account project managers are required to adhere to the following basic steps in order to successfully manage projects.

1. Complete Frontline Project Management certification.
2. Thorough understanding of the scope of work and history of the project.
3. Develop and maintain strong positive relationship with customers.
4. Work with senior account manager to service an existing account, and to ensure that the customer is being taken care of in a proper professional manner.
5. Project planning: To ensure that a project plan is developed and all required project tasks are accounted for, and completed on time and within budget.
6. Project implementation: To implement the project in a timely and controlled manner.
7. Project closing: To ensure that all contract requirements have been met; all customers are satisfied with the work performed; payments have been released; and warranty period has been properly initiated.

Engineering

VTI is capable of engineering the electronic security system needs of any size project, including drawing floor plans, risers, point-to-point and all custom projects. VTI's engineering staff consists of two engineers, one drafting engineer and one CAD operator. VTI uses AutoCAD for all drawing generation.
